To Ticket Agents, Ticket Receivers, Conductors, Ticket Examiners and Baggage Agents.

SUBJECT: Use of Tickets with Time Limit, expiring while in use en route.

If the time limit of a ticket or coupon, reading from a station on the Pennsylvania System west of Pittsburg, Oil City or Erie to a station on the Pennsylvania System east of Pittsburgh, Oil City or Erie expires while in use en route west of Pittsburgh, Oil City or Erie, the ticket is good in continuation of the trip for strictly continuus passage east of Pittsburgh, Oil City or Erie to the destination of the ticket or coupon.

Paragraph 32 of current manual of instructions to ticket receivers and conductors west of Pittsburgh, Oil City and Erie authorizes similar practice westbound, so that if the time limit of a ticket or coupon, reading from a station on the Pennsylvania System east of Pittsburgh, Oil City or Erie to a station on the Pennsylvania System west of Pittsburgh, Oil City or Erie expires while in use en route east of Pittsburgh, Oil City or Erie, the ticket is good in continuation of the trip for strictly continuous passage west of Pittsburgh, Oil City or Erie to the destination of the ticket or coupon.
