NEW TIME TABLES AND STOCK EDITIONS

When changes are made in passenger train service the affected time tables are reissued showing the new effective date and are distributed to all points on the mailing list.

Subsequent editions of time tables showing the same effective date are printed as required for replenishment of supplies to cover requisitions and are marked 2nd edition, 3rd edition, etc. These stock editions are not given a distribution and may contain minor adjustments in schedules or service over the previous editions. However, changes in passenger service are outlined in System Notices, which are sent to all Agents, and it is stated in these Notices when the time table will be reissued and distributed to cover the changes or whether the changes will be made in the next stock edition.

Time tables Forms 1 and 2 are issued and given regular distribution with new effective dates in February, April, July and October.

Instructions for Ordering Time Tables

It is important that time table distribution and stock be given careful supervision to avoid waste and the following instructions observed when ordering time tables:

- If your office is receiving too many time tables on the initial distribution, or forms that are not required, immediately notify the Supervisor, Time Tables.
- 2. Do not order more time tables than your office will require for a four week period.
- 3. Ticket and information clerks should be instructed to conserve the large system folders or divisional forms wherever possible, especially where a less expensive relief form will give the patron the desired information.
- 4. A duplicate copy of all requisitions for time tables should be kept and time tables received noted thereon to avoid duplicate requisitions for the same forms.
- 5. Telephone requests for time tables should not be made except in an emergency. Anticipate your requirements and order at least a week or 10 days in advance.

REQUISITIONS

Requisitions for time tables should be sent to Supervisor, Time Tables, Room 1244—Six Penn Center Plaza, Philadelphia, Pa. T. D. I. Suburban Forms are issued periodically and distribution to Agents is monthly based on a supply sufficient to last a month; therefore, it should not be necessary to requisition for additional supplies except in an emergency. If any change in monthly requirements is necessary, inform the Supervisor, Time Tables, Room 1244—Six Penn Plaza, Philadelphia, Pa.
