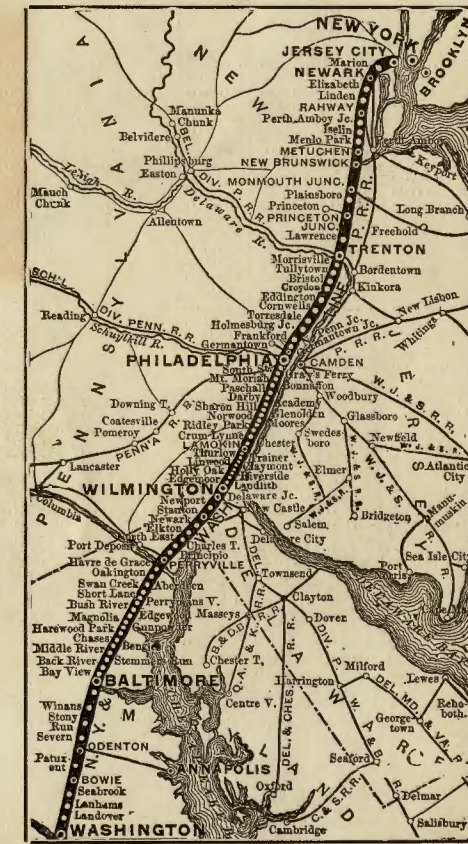

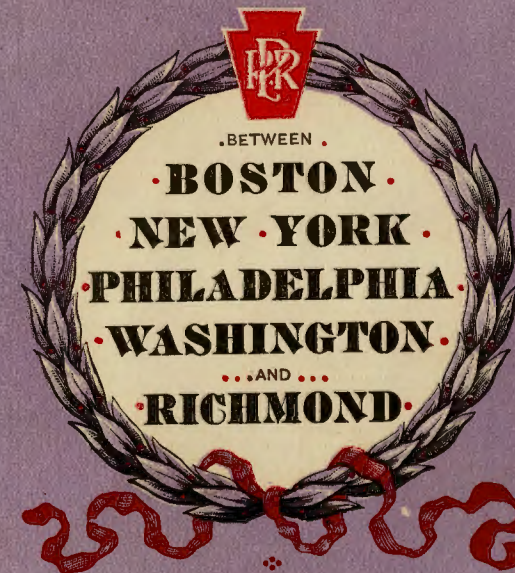
PENNSYLVANIA ROUTE

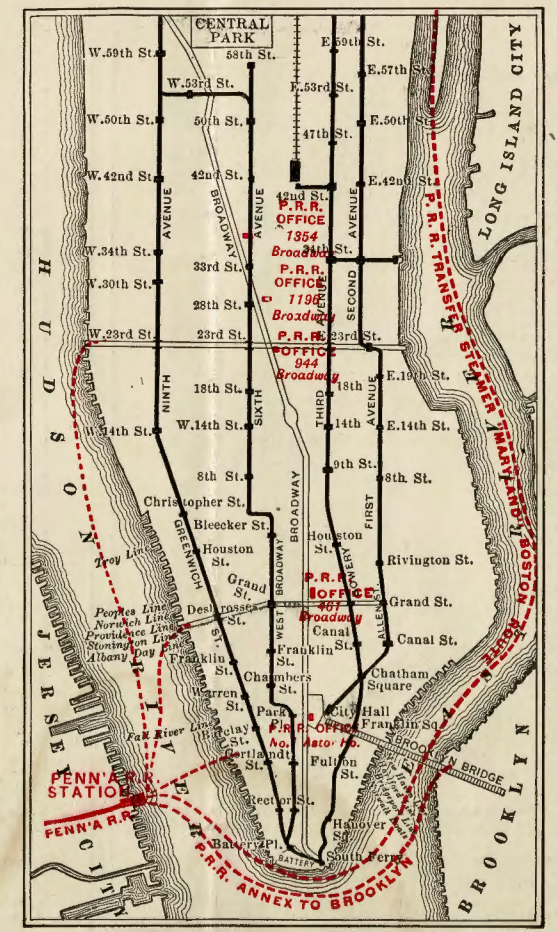
