ADJUSTMENT OF FARES—Should any misunderstanding arise with conductors or agents as to the proper fare or ticket privileges, please pay fare requested, take receipt and communicate with General Passenger Agent, Pennsylvania Station, Philadelphia 4.

CHILDREN—Under 5 years of age, free, when accompanied by parent or guardian; 5 years of age and under 12, one-half fare; 12 years of age and over, full fare.

RESPONSIBILITY—The Pennsylvania Railroad is not responsible for errors in time tables, nor for inconvenience or damage resulting from delayed trains or failure to make connections, or shortage of equipment. The schedules and equipment shown in time table are subject to change without notice.

FORWARDING OF BAGGAGE—Passengers are urged to check baggage in advance so that it may be forwarded on a preceding train. Every effort will be made to facilitate the handling of baggage, but the Railroad cannot guarantee the forwarding of baggage on the same train with owner; nor can time of arrival at destination which checked be guaranteed.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE—One hundred and fifty (150) pounds of baggage not exceeding one hundred (100.00) dollars in value may be checked without additional charge for each adult passenger, or seventy five (75) pounds not exceeding fifty (50.00) dollars in value for children.

BAGGAGE—WEIGHT, SIZE AND LIABILITY—No single piece of baggage exceeding 300 pounds in weight or 72 inches in greatest dimension, or single shipment exceeding \$2,500.00 in value, will be checked. Free allowance and liability is subject to tariff stipulations as to contents, weight, value and size.
