BAGGAGE DEFINED—Personal baggage consists of wearing apparel, toilet effects (except liquids) and similar personal effects in actual use, and necessary and appropriate for the wear, use, comfort and convenience of the passenger for the purpose of his journey, and not intended for other persons nor for sale, may be checked in baggage service. Money, jewelry, silverware, negotiable papers and like valuables, liquids, fragile or perishable articles, radios and household goods must not be enclosed in baggage to be checked; and the carriers will not be responsible for such articles enclosed in baggage.
