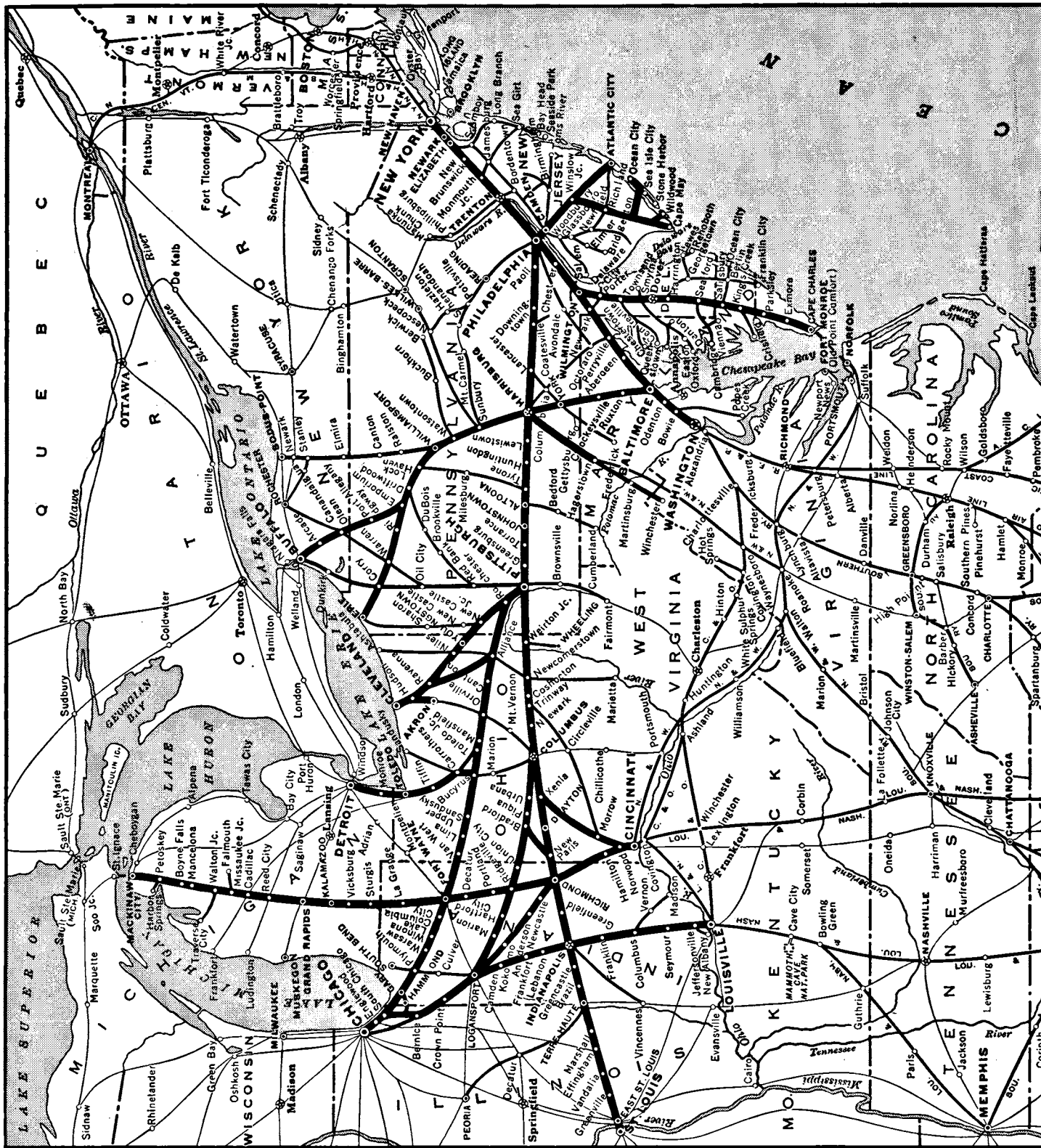

PASSENGER

THE TIME from 12.01 a. m. to 12 o'clock noon, inclusive, is indicated by light-face type; from 12.01 p. m. to 12 o'clock midnight, inclusive, by dark-face type.

AIR-CONDITIONED TRAINS AND RECLINING SEAT COACHES—Air-conditioned equipment and reclining seat coaches have been assigned to regular sections of certain trains. Every effort will be made to provide this equipment but the right is reserved to employ non-air-conditioned cars and non-reclining-seat coaches in such trains as may be necessitated by volume of traffic or operating contingencies.

ADJUSTMENT OF FARES—Should any misunderstanding arise with conductors or agents as to the proper fare or ticket privileges, please pay fare requested, take receipt and communicate with Chief of Tariff & Redemption Bureau, Pennsylvania Station (30th Street), Philadelphia 4, Pa.

CANCELLATION OF PULLMAN RESERVATIONS AND REDEMPTION OF PULLMAN TICKETS—If travel plans change CANCEL PULLMAN RESERVATIONS PROMPTLY to receive maximum refund and release space for others. Pullman tickets will not be redeemed at full value (less service charge) unless space is released before the day of departure of train for which sold. There is a 50% refund of the value (less service charge) if space is cancelled on day of train departure four or more hours before leaving time. Exception: During the period December 1 through April 30 Pullman tickets from stations north of Washington, D. C. to destinations in Florida south of Jacksonville, Fla. and Baldwin, Fla. will not be redeemed at full value if space was not released three days prior to departure of train for which sold. (Tickets for space in a car placed for occupancy before midnight but scheduled to depart at or after midnight and prior to 5.00 A. M. will be considered as having been sold for day on which car was placed for occupancy.)

Consult ticket agents regarding refunds or forward tickets direct to General Passenger Agent, Pullman Company, 165 North Canal Street, Chicago 6, Ill.

Exchange on day of departure—Under certain conditions, tickets for space which is released on the day of but not less than four hours before train departure will be exchanged by ticket agents for other tickets for corresponding trips commencing not more than seven days later. In no case will tickets issued in exchange be redeemed or again be exchanged.

A service charge of 50c per ticket will be made by agent for redemption or exchange of Pullman ticket.

CHILDREN—Under 5 years of age, free, when accompanied by parent or guardian, except children under 5 years of age occupying separate seat space on "The Southerner" over Southern Railway will be required to hold one-half adult railroad ticket. Children 5 years of age and under 12, one-half fare; 12 years of age and over, full fare.

PARLOR CARS—All parlor car service on the Pennsylvania Railroad, both local and interline is operated by the Pennsylvania Railroad Company.

RESPONSIBILITY—The Pennsylvania Railroad is not responsible for errors in time tables, nor for inconvenience or damage resulting from delayed trains or failure to make connections, or for shortage of equipment. The schedules and equipment shown in this time table are subject to change without notice.

RED CAP PORTER SERVICE is available at principal stations at a charge of 25¢ for each bag or parcel. Carriers' liability is limited to not more than \$50.00 for each bag or parcel, including its contents, unless greater value is declared in writing by passenger. An additional charge of 20¢ per bag or parcel will be made for each \$100.00 or fraction thereof declared in excess of \$50.00. A bag or parcel having value in excess of \$500.00 will not be accepted under any circumstances.

BAGGAGE

DEFINITION OF CHECKED BAGGAGE—Wearing apparel, toilet articles (except liquids) and personal effects—necessary or appropriate for the wear, use, comfort and convenience of the passenger for the purpose of his journey and not intended for other persons nor for sale. Money, jewelry, silverware, negotiable papers and like valuables, liquids, fragile or perishable articles, radios and household goods must not be included in checked baggage—the railroads will not be responsible for such articles.

MARKING BAGGAGE FOR IDENTIFICATION—Mark or tag each piece with your name and address and place your name and permanent address inside each piece, whether it is checked or carried with you on the train.

FORWARDING—Passengers are urged to check baggage in advance so that it may be forwarded on a preceding train. Every effort will be made to facilitate the handling of baggage, but the Railroad cannot guarantee to forward on same train with owner nor the arrival time at destination.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE—One hundred and fifty (150) pounds of baggage not exceeding one hundred (\$100.00) dollars in value for each adult passenger, and seventy-five (75) pounds not exceeding fifty (\$50.00) dollars in value for each child traveling on a one-half fare ticket will be transported in baggage cars without additional charge, except for a nominal baggage checking service charge of 25c per piece of hand baggage and 50c per trunk.

A charge is made for weight in excess of the above amounts. Passengers also have the privilege of declaring excess value on their baggage at a charge of twenty-five cents for each additional \$100.00 or fraction thereof over that allowed on their tickets. The valuation declared by one passenger may not exceed \$2,500.00.

MAXIMUM WEIGHT AND LIABILITY—No single piece of baggage exceeding 300 pounds in weight or single shipment exceeding \$2,500.00 in value, will be checked. Free allowance and liability is subject to tariff stipulation as to contents, weight and value.

DOGS and other small household pets are transported in baggage cars subject to tariff regulations. Dogs, cats or other animals (not venomous, odoriferous or otherwise objectionable) when carried in baskets or containers, may be taken by purchasers of Pullman private rooms into the rooms they occupy, subject to established regulations. Dogs may be on leash and muzzled instead of in containers.
