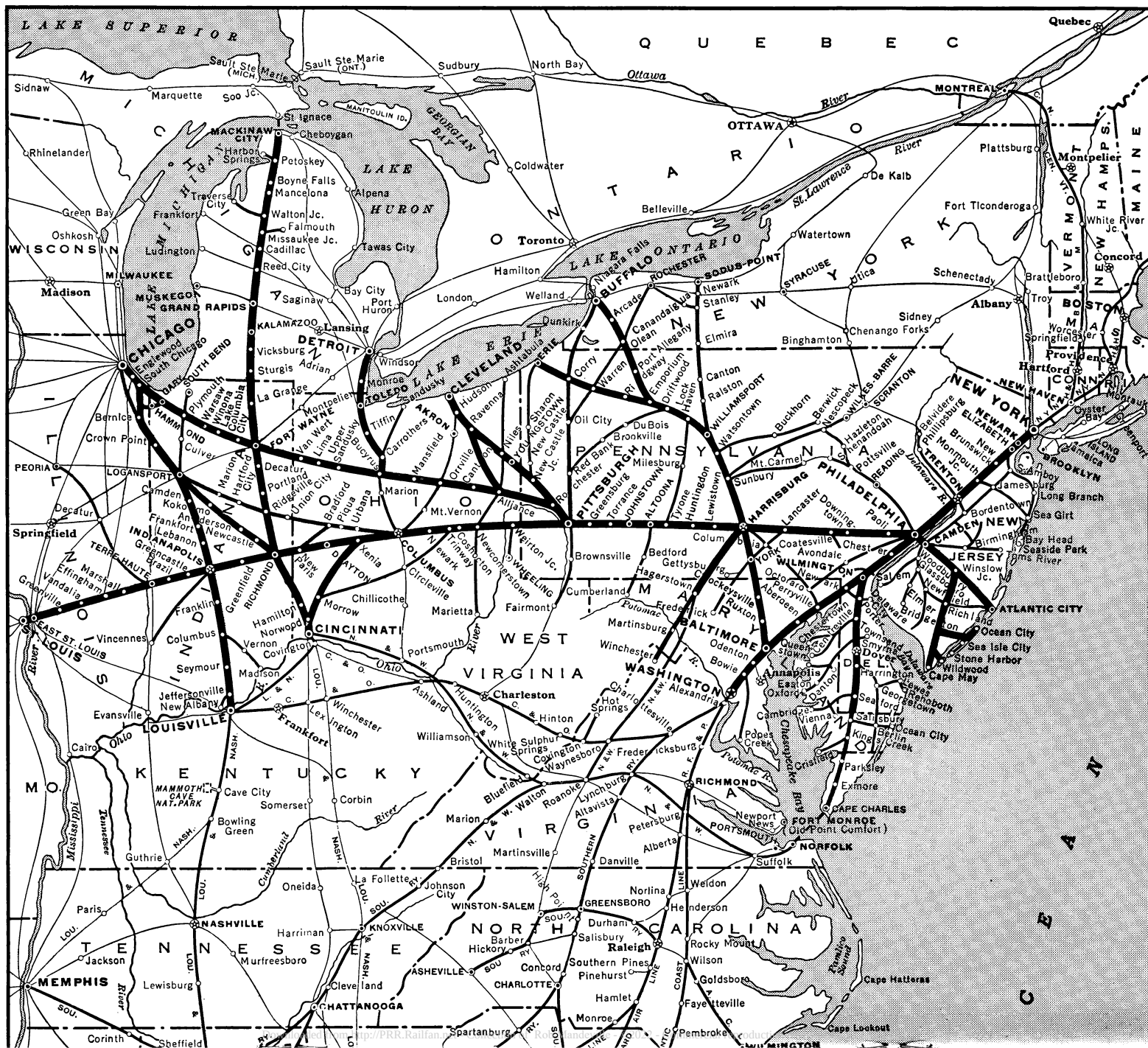

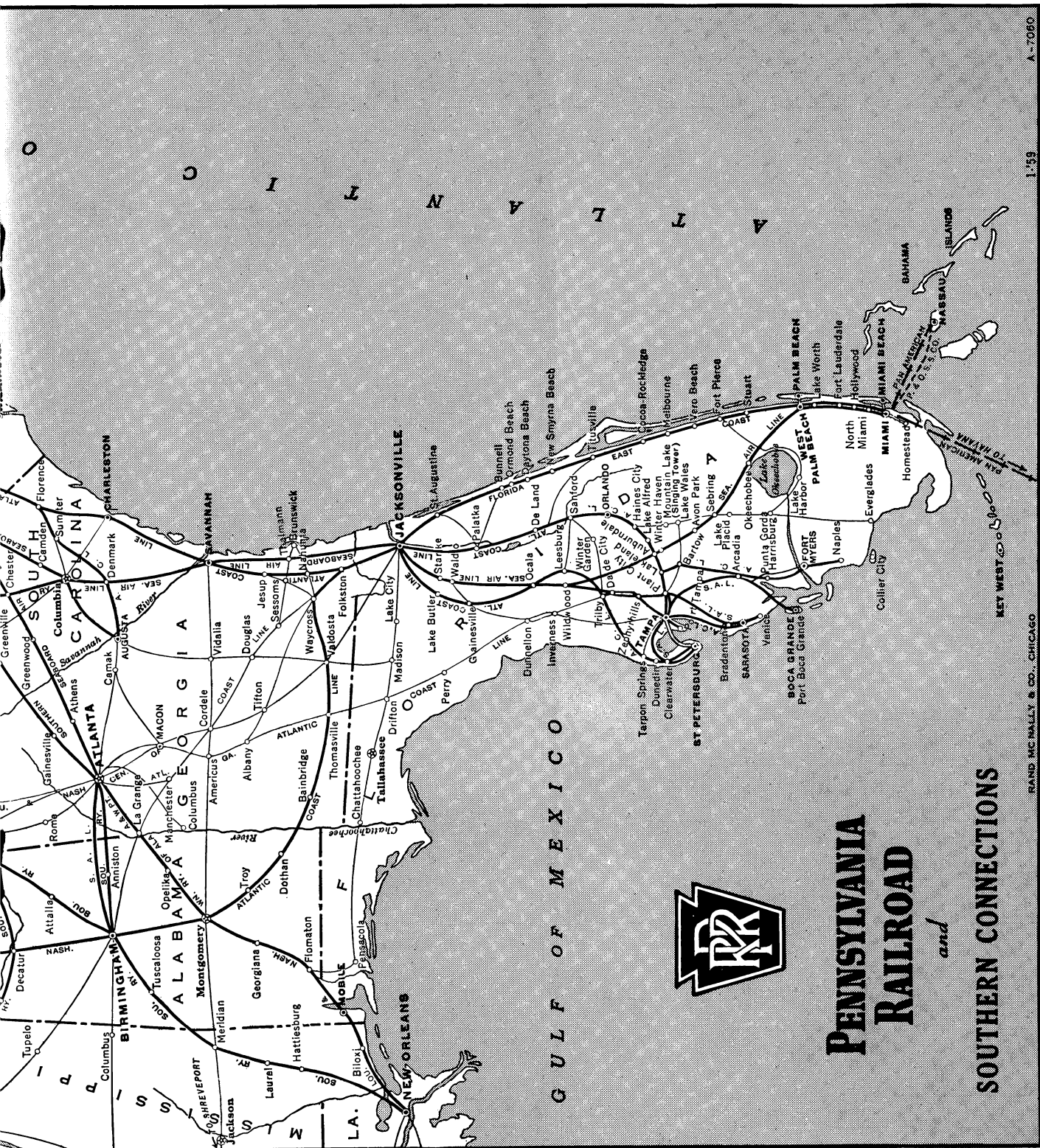

Pullman tickets will not be redeemed at full value (less service charge) unless space is released before the day of departure of train for which sold. CHILDREN under 5 years of age travel free when accompanied by parent or guardian; half fare is charged children 5 years of age and under 12; all persons 12 and over pay full fare.

PARLOR CARS—All parlor car service on the Pennsylvania Railroad, both local and interline is operated by the Pennsylvania Railroad Company.

RESPONSIBILITY—The Pennsylvania Railroad is not responsible for errors in time tables, nor for inconvenience or damage resulting from delayed trains or failure to make connections, or for shortage of equipment. The schedules and equipment shown in this time table are subject to change without notice.

RED CAP PORTER SERVICE is available at principal stations at a charge of 35¢ for each bag or parcel. Carriers' liability is limited to not more than \$50.00 for each bag or parcel, including its contents, unless greater value is declared in writing by passenger. An additional charge of 20¢ per bag or parcel will be made for each \$100.00 or fraction thereof declared in excess of \$50.00. A bag or parcel having value in excess of \$500.00 will not be accepted under any circumstances.

BAGGAGE

DEFINITION OF CHECKED BAGGAGE—Wearing apparel, toilet articles (except liquids) and personal effects—necessary or appropriate for the wear, use, comfort and convenience of the passenger for the purpose of his journey and not intended for other persons nor for sale. Money, jewelry, silverware, negotiable papers and like valuables, liquids, fragile or perishable articles, radios and household goods must not be included in checked baggage—the railroads will not be responsible for such articles.

MARKING BAGGAGE FOR IDENTIFICATION—Mark or tag each piece with your name and address and place your name and permanent address inside each piece, whether it is checked or carried with you on the train.

FORWARDING—Passengers are urged to check baggage in advance so that it may be forwarded on a preceding train. Every effort will be made to facilitate the handling of baggage, but the Railroad cannot guarantee to forward on same train with owner nor the arrival time at destination.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE—One hundred and fifty (150) pounds of baggage not exceeding one hundred (\$100.00) dollars in value for each adult passenger, and seventy-five (75) pounds not exceeding fifty (\$50.00) dollars in value for each child traveling on a one-half fare ticket will be transported in baggage cars without additional charge, except for a nominal baggage checking service charge of 25¢ per piece of hand baggage and 50¢ per trunk.

A charge is made for weight in excess of the above amounts. Passengers also have the privilege of declaring excess value on their baggage at a charge of twenty-five cents for each additional \$100.00 or fraction thereof over that allowed on their tickets. The valuation declared by one passenger may not exceed \$2,500.00.

MAXIMUM WEIGHT AND LIABILITY—No single piece of baggage exceeding 300 pounds in weight or single shipment exceeding \$2,500.00 in value, will be checked. Free allowance and liability is subject to tariff stipulation as to contents, weight and value.

DOGS and other small household pets are transported in baggage cars subject to tariff regulations. Dogs, cats or other animals (not venomous, odorous or otherwise objectionable) when carried in baskets or containers, may be taken by purchasers of Pullman private rooms into the rooms they occupy, subject to established regulations. Dogs may be on leash and muzzled instead of in containers.
