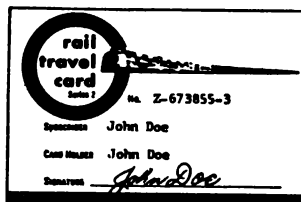

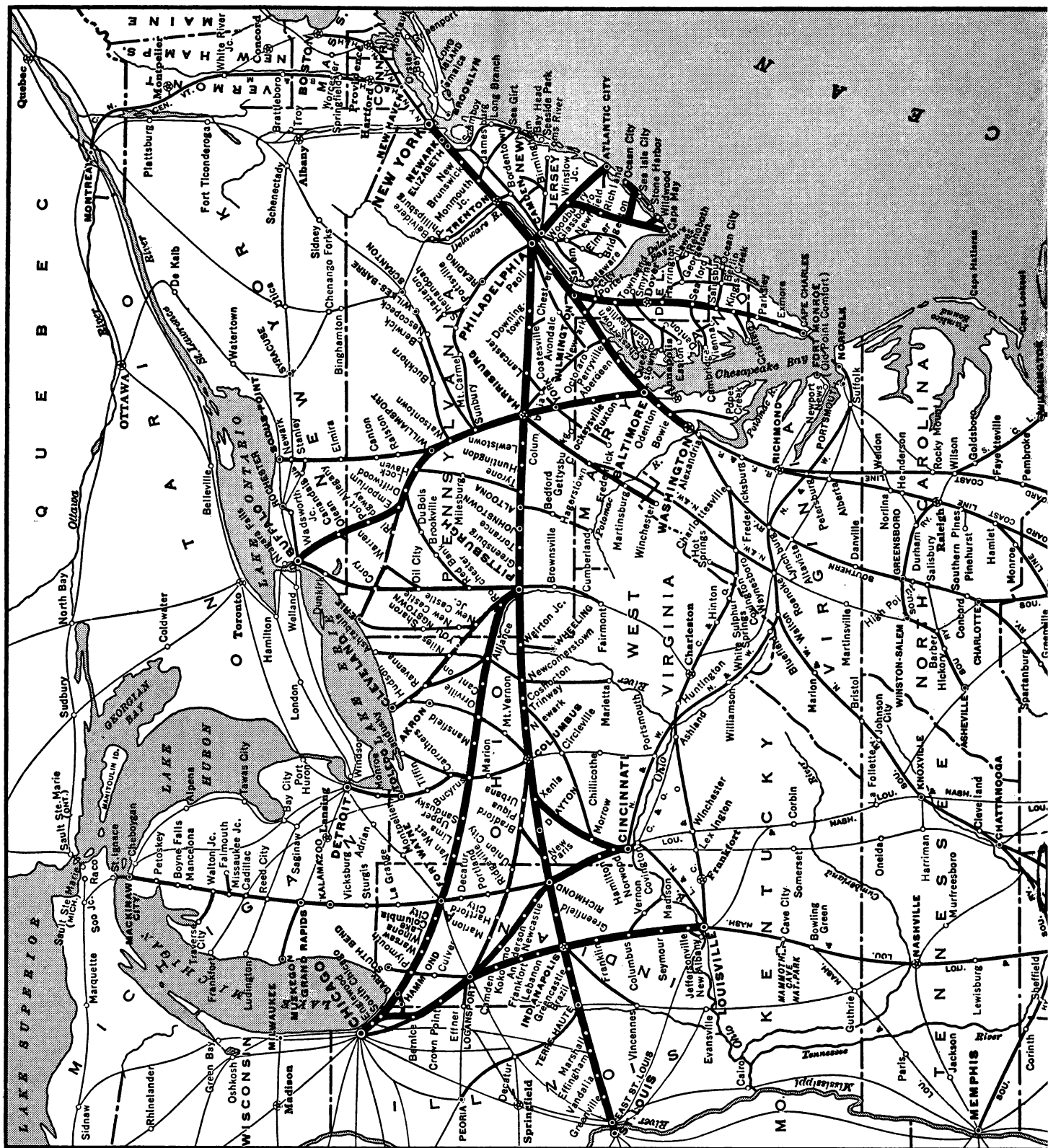

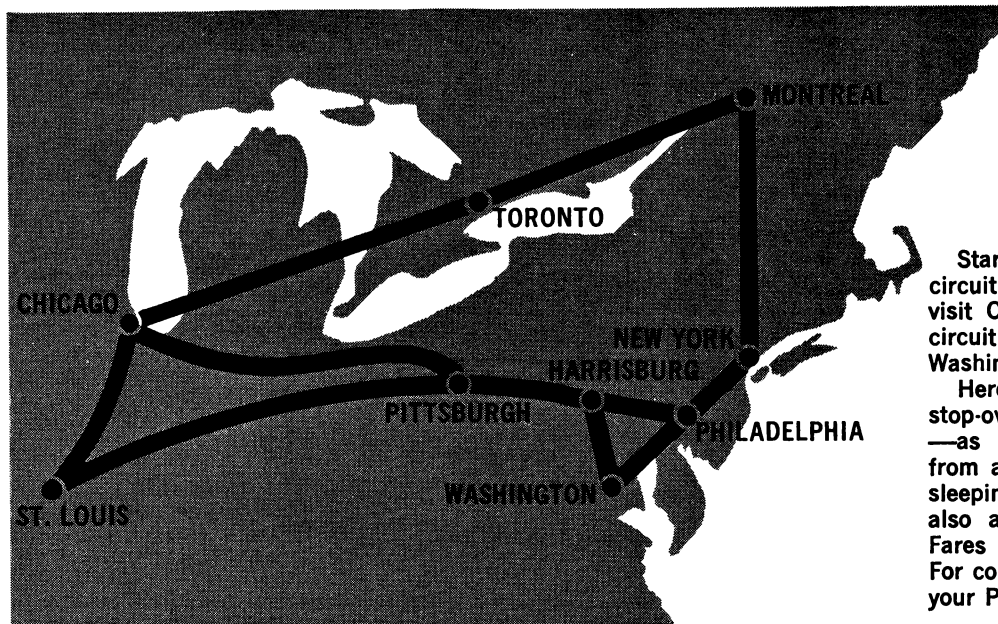

AIR-CONDITIONED TRAINS AND RECLINING SEAT COACHES—Air-conditioned equipment and reclining seat coaches have been assigned to regular sections of certain trains. Every effort will be made to provide this equipment but the right is reserved to employ non-air-conditioned cars and non-reclining-seat coaches in such trains as may be necessitated by volume of traffic or operating contingencies.

REFUND OF TICKETS—Requests for the redemption of unused portions of tickets should be sent to the Manager of Revenue Accounting, 15 N. 32nd St., Phila., Pa. 19104.

ADJUSTMENT OF FARES—Should any question arise as to the proper fare or ticket privileges please pay fare requested, obtain receipt and communicate with Manager, Passenger Service Bureau, Pennsylvania Station (30th Street), Philadelphia, Pa. 19104.

CANCELLATION OF PULLMAN RESERVATIONS AND REDEMPTION OF PULLMAN TICKETS—If travel plans change CANCEL PULLMAN RESERVATIONS PROMPTLY to receive maximum refund and release space for others. Pullman tickets will not be redeemed at full value (less service charge) unless space is released before the day of departure of train for which sold. There is a 50% refund of the value (less service charge) if space is cancelled on day of train departure four or more hours before leaving time. Exception: During the period December 1 through April 30 Pullman tickets from stations north of Washington, D. BAGGAGE

DEFINITION OF CHECKED BAGGAGE—Wearing apparel, toilet articles (except liquids) and personal effects—necessary or appropriate for the wear, use, comfort and convenience of the passenger for the purpose of his journey and not intended for other persons nor for sale. Money, jewelry, silverware, negotiable papers and like valuables, liquids, fragile or perishable articles, radios and household goods must not be included in checked baggage—the railroads will not be responsible for such articles.

FORWARDING—Passengers are urged to check baggage in advance so that it may be forwarded on a preceding train. Every effort will be made to facilitate the handling of baggage, but the Railroad cannot guarantee to forward on same train with owner nor the arrival time at destination.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE—One hundred and fifty (150) pounds of baggage not exceeding one hundred (\$100.00) dollars in value for each adult passenger, and seventy-five (75) pounds not exceeding fifty (\$50.00) dollars in value for each child traveling on a one-half fare ticket will be transported in baggage cars without additional charge, except for a nominal baggage checking service charge of 35¢ per piece of hand baggage and 75¢ per trunk.

A charge is made for weight in excess of the above amounts. Passengers also have the privilege of declaring excess value on their baggage at a charge of thirty cents for each additional \$100.00 or fraction thereof over that allowed on their tickets. The valuation declared by one passenger may not exceed \$2,500.00.

MAXIMUM WEIGHT AND LIABILITY—No single piece of baggage exceeding 300 pounds in weight or single shipment exceeding \$2,500.00 in value, will be checked. Free allowance and liability is subject to tariff stipulation as to contents, weight and value.

DOGS and other small household pets in substantial crates or cages will be carried in baggage cars as provided in tariffs. Dogs, cats or other animals (not venomous, odoriferous or otherwise objectionable) when carried in baskets or containers, may be taken by purchasers of Pullman private rooms into the rooms they occupy, subject to established regulations. Dogs may be on leash and muzzled instead of in containers.
