INFORMATION

CHILDREN—Under 5 years of age, free, when accompanied by parent or guardian; 5 years of age and under 12, one-half fare. 12 years of age and over, full fare.

RESPONSIBILITY—The Pennsylvania Railroad is not responsible for errors in time tables, nor for inconvenience or damage resulting from delayed trains or failure to make connections, or for shortage of equipment. The schedules and equipment shown in this time table are subject to change without notice.

CHECKING AND DELIVERY OF BAGGAGE—Passengers are advised to check their baggage to home address, hotel, club, office, steamship pier, etc., at destination, thereby insuring prompt delivery. This can be arranged upon telephone request to the Railway Express Agency or other authorized transfer companies or to agent, or checkman at starting point, and the transfer charge may be paid at time of checking or when baggage is delivered at destination.

FORWARDING OF BAGGAGE—Passengers are urged to check baggage in advance so that it may be forwarded on a preceding train. Every effort will be made to facilitate the handling of baggage, but the Railroad cannot guarantee to forward on same train with owner, nor arrival at destination to which checked.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE—One hundred and fifty (150) pounds of baggage not exceeding one hundred (100.00) dollars in value may be checked without additional charge for each adult passenger, and seventy-five (75) pounds not exceeding fifty (50.00) dollars in value for each child traveling on a one-half fare ticket.
