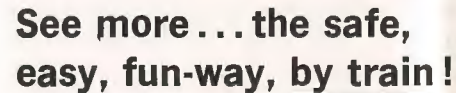

Sleeping Cars open for occupancy in New York at 10.30 P. M., in Philadelphia 10.00 P. M., in Washington (Train No. 176 at 9.30 P. M., and Train No. 108 at 10.00 P. M.) and may be occupied in New York until 7.00 A. M.

TRAIN TELEPHONE SERVICE—A coin box telephone booth is located in one of the parlor cars on Trains Nos. 152 and 153 (Except Saturdays and Nov. 7, 10, 23, 24, Jan. 1, Feb. 22 and Apr. 12). Local or long distance calls may be made by parlor car passengers while traveling between New York and Washington. Your car porter will be glad to tell you the location of the phone.
