## INFORMATION

### PASSENGER

**AIR-CONDITIONED TRAINS**—Air-conditioned equipment has been assigned to regular sections of certain trains. Every effort will be made to provide this equipment. But on occasions volume of travel or other conditions make it necessary to use non-air-conditioned cars and the Pennsylvania Railroad reserves the right to do so.

**REFUND OF TICKETS**—Requests for the redemption of unused portions of tickets should be sent to the Manager of Revenue Accounting, 15 N. 32nd St., Phila., Pa. 19104.

**ADJUSTMENT OF FARES**—Should any question arise as to the proper fare or ticket privileges, please pay fare requested, obtain receipt and communicate with Manager, Passenger Service Bureau, Pennsylvania Station (30th Street), Philadelphia, Pa. 19104.

**CHILDREN**—Under 5 years of age travel free when accompanied by a parent or guardian. However, when one or more children under 5 years of age occupy a Parlor Car seat one-half (½) fare rail ticket, in addition to the full seat charge, is required. One-half fare is charged for children 5 years of age and under 12. All persons 12 years and over pay the adult fare.

**MEETING FRIENDS**—Because Pennsylvania Railroad trains are sometimes operated in more than one section, it will be helpful to friends who plan to meet you to know the number or designation of the Sleeping car or coach in which you have your reservation.

At larger stations, a convenient central point to meet is the Information Bureau.

**PARLOR CARS**—All parlor car service on the Pennsylvania Railroad, both local and interline, is operated by the Pennsylvania Railroad.

**RESPONSIBILITY**—The Pennsylvania Railroad is not responsible for errors in time tables, nor for inconvenience or damage resulting from delayed trains or failure to make connections, or for shortage of equipment. The schedules and equipment shown in this time table are subject to change without notice.

### BAGGAGE

**CHECKABLE BAGGAGE DEFINED**—Personal baggage consists of wearing apparel, toilet articles, (except liquids) and personal effects necessary for comfort and convenience and not intended for other persons or for sale. Not checkable are money, jewelry, silverware, negotiable papers and like articles, liquids, fragile or perishable articles, radios, televisions and household goods. Railroads will not be responsible for such articles.

**BAGGAGE CHECKING ALLOWANCE AND SERVICE CHARGE**—All baggage checked subject to tariff regulations. 150 pounds will be transported on full-fare ticket and 75 pounds on half-fare ticket, for a service charge of 35¢ on each suitcase or other piece of hand luggage and 75¢ on each trunk. This charge is payable at time of checking. There is an additional charge for baggage exceeding \$100. In value on a full-fare ticket and \$50. on a half-fare ticket. No single piece of baggage exceeding 300 pounds in weight or exceeding \$2,500. in value will be checked. Identify each piece both inside and out with your name and permanent address.

**CHECK BAGGAGE IN ADVANCE**—Some trains do not carry baggage, so it is good practice to check baggage a day in advance of your trip. Baggage is handled as promptly as possible but arrival time can not be guaranteed. Pick up your baggage promptly at destination, there are storage charges if not claimed within 24 hours.

**FREE USE OF SELF SERVICE LUGGAGE CARTS** at Union Station, Washington, D. C. available on train platforms and at entrances.
