IMPORTANT NOTICE to North German Lloyd Passengers

1. Baggage is checked direct to steamship without transfer.
No hotel bill necessary in New York. Passenger will not have to stop over in New York. These trains are scheduled to arrive in Brooklyn (Bay Ridge), New York, in ample time for sailing of the Bremen, Europa and Columbus, and to attend to all details of personal business before boarding ship.
2. No change of cars necessary at any point. The Pennsylvania Railroad Boat Trains take North German Lloyd passengers right to Pier No. 4, Brooklyn (Bay Ridge), New York.
3. Dining car service for all passengers. Luncheon service in coaches for those who do not desire to go into dining cars.
Representative of the Pennsylvania Railroad will accompany each of the Boat Trains to see that passengers are given every attention necessary for their comfort, convenience and pleasure.
4. By using the Pennsylvania Railroad-North German Lloyd Boat Trains, passengers of the Bremen, Europa and Columbus will have an opportunity to become acquainted with many of their fellow steamer passengers before boarding ship.

Note: All Boat Trains leave points shown under "Schedules and Fares" the SECOND DAY BEFORE STEAMER SAILS (with two exceptions—Crestline and Mansfield, Ohio), arriving BROOKLYN (BAY RIDGE), New York, 2 hours and 45 minutes before boat sails.

Baggage Checked Direct to Steamer

Passengers using Pennsylvania Railroad-North German Lloyd Boat Trains should purchase tickets to "BROOKLYN (BAY RIDGE), NEW YORK, which is the railroad station for North German Lloyd Express Trio, the S.S. BREMEN, S.S. EUROPA, and the S.S. COLUMBUS.

Your BAGGAGE should be checked to "BROOKLYN (BAY RIDGE), NEW YORK."

By checking your baggage direct to Brooklyn (Bay Ridge), New York, there will be no transfer necessary at New York and it will go through in special baggage cars to North German Lloyd Pier No. 4, where it will be placed on board ship.

Baggage may be checked any time in advance and will be forwarded in special baggage cars which will be attached to train at New York.

RAILROAD FARES

Through railroad tickets should be purchased to "BROOKLYN (BAY RIDGE), NEW YORK," at fares 80 cents higher than the regular fares in effect to New York City.

PULLMAN FARES

Pullman tickets should be purchased to New York City *only*, at regular rates applying. On arrival New York City, a collection of 75 cents will be made from each person for Pullman accommodations to Bay Ridge.

ARRIVING TIME—Boat Trains arrive Pennsylvania Station, New York, 7.50 p.m., and at Bay Ridge (Brooklyn), New York, at 8.45 p.m.

RATES from points west of Chicago may be figured by adding eighty cents to the one-way railroad fare to New York, and by adding seventy-five cents to the berth rate.

EXAMPLE

Non-Extra Fare Boat Train leaving Chicago at 3.00 p.m., first day, arrives Pittsburgh, Pa., 7.10 a.m., and leaves Pittsburgh 9.40 a.m., second day, arriving Pennsylvania Station, New York, 7.50 p.m., leaves Pennsylvania Station 7.50 p.m., arriving Brooklyn (Bay Ridge Station), New York, 8.45 p.m., second day, for steamers sailing at 12.30 a.m., Daylight Saving Time, third day.

Fast Extra Fare Boat Train leaving Chicago at 9.00 p.m., first day, arrives Pittsburgh next morning at 8.30 a.m., Pennsylvania Station New York, at 7.50 p.m., leaves Pennsylvania Station, New York, at 7.50 p.m., arriving Brooklyn (Bay Ridge Station), New York, at 8.45 p.m., day after departure from Chicago, arriving Pier No. 4, two hours and forty-five minutes before ship's sailing at 12.30 p.m., Daylight Saving Time, following morning.
