

## INFORMATION

**1. Monthly Commutation Tickets.**—A 54-trip monthly commutation ticket is good for 54 single continuous trips, during the calendar month for which issued, for the personal use of purchaser, whose signature must be affixed to ticket at time of sale.

If issued on the graduated payment plan, one commutation ticket must be purchased each month, consecutively month after month, *at the same ticket office*, all for the use of the same person. If one or more months are permitted to elapse and it is desired to continue on the graduated payment plan, the purchaser must begin again at the first month fare.

If issued on the single payment plan, one commutation ticket for each month for a term of 3, 6 or 12 successive calendar months must be purchased at one time, all for use of the same person. When all of the tickets of a single payment term have been used or limit has expired, and it is desired to continue use of monthly commutation tickets, the purchaser must begin at the first month fare or purchase tickets on the single payment plan.

**2. Season and Annual Tickets.**—A 20-trip season ticket is good for 20 single continuous trips, a 50-trip season ticket for 50 single continuous trips, a 100-trip season ticket for 100 single continuous trips, a 150-trip season ticket for 150 single continuous trips, and a 100-trip annual ticket for 100 single continuous trips, within the limit of ticket, for the personal use of purchaser, whose signature and photograph must be affixed to ticket at time of sale. The **photograph** must show a good likeness of applicant, and not exceed 1¼ inches in size. A new copy of photograph must be furnished by applicant for each ticket.

100-trip annual tickets are on sale daily and are good for one year in addition to date of issue.

A 50-trip family ticket is good for 50 continuous trips, for use of the purchaser whose personal signature is affixed thereto, and dependent members of the purchaser's immediate family living under the same roof, a coupon to be surrendered for each passenger five years of age or over.

50-trip family tickets are on sale daily and are good for one year in addition to date of issue.

20-trip and 50-trip season tickets are on sale May 1 to October 31, inclusive, and are good for three successive calendar months, including month of issue, but not exceeding October 31 of year of issue.

100-trip season tickets and 150-trip season tickets are on sale April 1 to October 31, inclusive, and are good for six successive calendar months, including month of issue, but not exceeding October 31 of year of issue.

**3. Diversion of Tickets.**—Commutation tickets sold at the fares shown herein are good from or to Pennsylvania Station, New York, on payment of supplementary fare of 15 cents per trip or the cancellation of a block of 25-trip Pennsylvania Station supplemental yearly tickets sold at fare of \$3.75. They are also good from or to New York via Central Railroad of New Jersey, and if issued for a station south of Little Silver, tickets are also good via Sandy Hook Route during the period of navigation.
