Low Home Signal governing southward movements on No. 1 track, located 829 feet north of Mile Post 52, in

Interlocked facing point switch for northward movements from single main track at TIDE, in service. Fixed Signal No. 544, located 3,073 feet north of Mile Post 55, governing northward movements on single main track, in service.

Low home signal located 4,941 feet south of Mile Post 56 governing southward movements on No. 1 track, out of service. Facing interlocked crossover for southward movement between No. 1 and No. 2 tracks at Mile Post 57, out of service.

Special Instructions 1151-B1, 1157-C1 and 1250-A1, changed.

### (a-u) ATLANTIC INTERLOCKING

Hand-operated crossover between No. 1 and No. 2 station tracks changed to spring switches.

The normal position of switch on No. 1 track will be for southward movement.

A northward movement from south end of No. 1 track will be to No. 2 track thereby springing switch on No. 2 track. Trains must stop north of crossover on No. 1 track and when engine is detached from train the engine must not be stopped until clear of south end of crossover.

When a movement is to be made from south end of crossover on No. 1 track spring switch must be operated by hand and after move is completed switch must be returned to normal position.

Reflector type switch target on No. 2 track, will display white banner and green disc when switch is in normal position, yellow banner and yellow disc when switch is in reverse position.

Hand-operated crossover between No. 7 and 8 station tracks changed to spring switches.

The normal position of switch on No. 8 track will be for southward movement.

A northward movement from south end of No. 8 track will be to No. 7 track thereby springing switch on No. 7 track. Trains must stop north of crossover on No. 8 track and when engine is detached from train the engine must not be stopped until clear of south end of crossover.

When a movement is to be made from south end of crossover from No. 8 track spring switch must be operated by hand and after move is completed switch must be returned to normal position.

Reflector type switch target on No. 7 track, will display white banner and green disc when switch is in normal position, yellow banner and yellow disc when switch is in reverse position.

When placing cars on No. 1 and No. 8 station tracks they must be placed north of crossover.

Electric locks removed from crossover between No. 1, No. 2 track, and between No. 7 and No. 8 tracks.

### (a-v) NEWFIELD SECONDARY TRACK

#### **PLEASANTVILLE**

A highway crossing designated as Second Street, 688 feet north of Main Street, Pleasantville, in service.

Before making movement over Second Street, on Newfield Secondary Track, Somers Point Secondary Track, a member of the crew must be stationed on crossing to give warning to persons using the highway.

Special Instruction 1103-C1, changed.

#### (a-w) PLEASANTVILLE

Facing hand-operated switch for northward movement with hand-operated derail, 550 feet north of Mile Post 59 leading to Lake and Risley Lumber Co., capacity 5 cars, in service.

That portion of delivery track extending southward from Second Street to Lake and Risley Lumber Co., out of service.

# Applies in Zone D

### (a-x) CENTER-ALAN

No. 1 track between a point 126 feet west of Center Interlocking Station and a point 281 feet west of Alan Interlocking Station, out of service.

### (a-y) CENTER-JERSEY

Manual Block Signal System Rules 305 to 373 inclusive, in effect except Rule 316, for movement against the current of traffic.

Special Instruction 1250-A1, changed.

# (aa-a) JERSEY, Interlocking

Connecting tracks between Divide, Jersey and Minson

Trains or engines must approach DeRousse Avenue and Curtis Avenue prepared to stop unless it is known that automatic highway crossing protection is operating.

If automatic highway crossing protection is not operating before making movement over crossing a member of the crew must be stationed on crossing to give warning to persons using the highway.

### (aa-b) PAVONIA DISTRICT

#### PETTY ISLAND MOVABLE BRIDGE

On the track leading to Cities Service Company on Petty Island, train and engine movements must stop on track circuit marked with "CC" sign 115 feet east of westward movable bridge signal and after an interval of five minutes the westward movable bridge signal will clear.

Westward movements must clear "CC" sign located 85 feet west of eastward movable bridge signal releasing crossing protection for highway traffic.

Trains or engines must not exceed a speed of ten miles per hour between movable bridge signals, prepared to stop looking for highway vehicles that may be on the bridge.

### (aa-c) PENSAUKEN INDUSTRIAL PARK

Before making movement over Suckle Highway on track leading to Standard Brands Incorporated or to International Harvester Co., trains or engines must stop before passing over this crossing and a member of the crew must be stationed on highway to give warning to persons using the highway.

### **IERSEY-VERNON**

(Temporary Speed Restriction)

Trains and engines on No. 1 and No. 2 tracks must not exceed a speed of 50 miles per hour between Divide and Vernon account of track conditions.

#### (aa-c) JERSEY-VERNON

#### RACE

Race Block Station in service 10.30 A.M. to 6.30 P.M. Tuesday, October 30, 1962 to Wednesday, December 5, 1962 inclusive except Sundays and Monday, November 5. Crossover between No. 2 and No. 1 track, trailing switch in No. 1 track and switches at north end of storage tracks, in charge of Operator at Race when Block Station is open.

Southward trains receiving a restricting signal at Race Block Station must stop before accepting fixed signal and must not proceed until a hand signal with a yellow flag or yellow light is received from Operator at Race which will indicate switches are properly lined for intended movement to storage tracks. been made, it will be necessary for a member of the crew to operate push button located on relay case, south side of Chester Avenue, 30 seconds before departure of train.

Southward trains consuming more than two minutes between Chester Avenue and Chestnut Street, 856 feet south of Moorestown, must approach Chestnut Street prepared to stop unless flashing light signals are operating preperly. If flashing light highway crossing signals are not operating properly, a member of the crew must protect crossing in advance of each movement over the crossing. Special Instruction 1103-A5, changed.

### (aa-g) STANWICK AVENUE-HARTFORD

At RCA private crossing No. 2, 166 feet south of Mile Post 12 automatic highway crossing gates and flashing light highway crossing signals, in service.

### (aa-h) PEMBERTON-CAMP

That portion of track between Pemberton Block-Limit Station and Camp, changed from Main track to Running track of no assigned direction designated as Dix Running Track. Rule 112 will apply on this track. Dix Running Track controlled by Birmingham when in service, by Cooper when Birmingham is not in service.

Special Instructions 1151-A1, 1151-G1 and 1250-A1, changed.

Pemberton Block-Limit Station for southward movement, out of service.

End of Block Sign 500 feet south of Pemberton Station for southward movement, in service.

Trains or engines must not exceed a speed of 15 miles per hour between end of Block Sign at Pemberton and Camp. Special Instruction 1157-C1, changed.

Yard Limit boards located 2,100 feet north of Lewis and 2,150 feet south of Lewis, out of service.

Special Instruction 1093-A1, changed.

From a point 51 feet south of Lewis to Camp present siding will be the Running Track and former Main Track between these points, out of service.

#### (aa-i) KINKORA SECONDARY TRACK

COLUMBUS, South of

Kinkora Secondary Track from 2,000 feet south of Columbus to Kinkora, out of service.

Special Instruction 1151-D1, changed.

# (aa-j) BORDENTOWN BRANCH

Interrupting Operation of Automatic Highway Crossing Protection Automatically

Apparatus to interrupt the operation of the automatic highway crossing protection automatically on No. 1 Track at Hylton Road, Palmyra, out of service.

Special Instruction 1103-A5, changed.

## (aa-k) PERKINS-BURLINGTON

Fixed signals 545 feet east of Mile Post 14, on No. 1 track, out of service.

Distant switch signal 2,047 feet east of Mile Post 15 on No. 1 track, in service.

Facing hand-operated switch for eastward movement in No. 1 track with pipe connected derail 1,756 feet east of Mile Post 16 leading to Cary Chemical Co., capacity 15 cars, in service.

#### (aa-l) BURLINGTON

Highway traffic signals at Broad and High Streets, Burlington, coordinated with rail traffic, in service.

Trains approaching High Street will cause highway signals to display aspects as follows:

High Street-Red

Green Arrow, Vertical Green Arrow, Right.

Broad Street—Red Green Arrow, Right.

Before train movements are made over High Street the above traffic signal indication must be displayed on Broad Street

Rule 4103-B applies when the traffic signals do not display aspects as indicated above on Broad Street. Protection must be provided in accordance with Rule 103 or crossing protected by Burlington City Police.

### (aa-m) BURLINGTON

At Keim Street 390 feet west of Burlington Station, westward trains or engines consuming two minutes and thirty seconds or longer from a point 1,780 feet east of Keim Street to Keim Street must approach crossing prepared to stop and a member of the crew must protect the crossing in advance of movement over the highway if flashing light highway crossing signals are not operating.

## (aa-n) ROEBLING

At Knickerbocker Road 70 feet west of Roebling Station, crossing watchmen on duty 7.00 A.M., Monday until 7.00 A.M., Sunday.

During the hours crossing watchmen are not on duty trains and engines must stop and a member of the crew must protect the crossing in advance of each movement over the crossing.

Special Instruction 1103-B1, changed.
