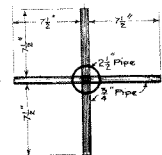


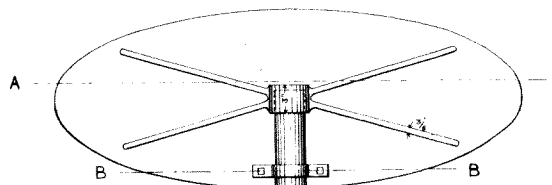
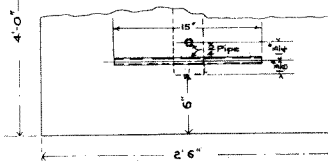

BACK VIEW

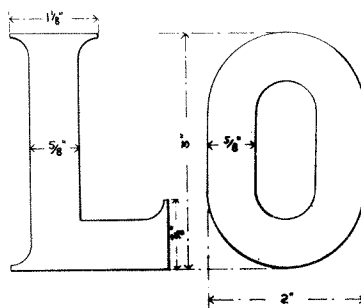
SECTION AT A-A

Letters and border raised 1/8 in.

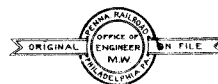


SCALE FOR LETTERS

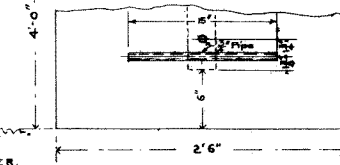

ground and all cinder fills.
When concrete or stone foundations
are not used the post is to be
planted 4'-6" deep in the ground.
