





PLAN

Manufacturer's name or trade mark of P.R.R. Shop where manufactured and P.R.R. monogram cast on this surface with characters not less than $\frac{1}{16}$ in height.

NOTE:

Springs shall be marked with the manufacturer's name or trade mark, The Pennsylvania Railroad Monogram and the weight and designation of rail with which the spring shall be used, in stamped or raised characters in the positions indicated.

Shoes shall be marked with the manufacturer's name or trade mark, The Pennsylvania Railroad Monogram and the weights and designation of the rails cast in raised characters in the positions indicated.

All characters shall be so defined that they may be read as long as the Anti-Creeper is in service.

When Anti-Creepers are made in P.R.R. shops the name of the shop shall be given in place of the manufacturer's name or trade mark.

Tool for applying and removing Anti-Creepers is shown on P.R.R. Plan, number 69368 - basic number.
